Post Boxes are affixed to the cars of the Hazel Grove Tramway Company, and the letters posted therein are collected on the arrival of the trams in St. Petersgate, between 9.30 a.m. and 10 p.m.

**POSTAL RATES.**

Letters—Not exceeding 4oz. 1d., and ½d. for every additional 2oz. No letter may exceed 2 feet long, 1 foot wide, or 1 foot deep. Letters posted unpaid are charged double postage on delivery; those insufficiently paid, double the deficiency.

Newspapers—Newspapers, registered at G.P.O., ½d. each; unregistered, ¼d. for every 2oz. A packet of newspapers must not weigh above 5lbs, or exceed 2 feet in length or 1 foot in width or depth.

Book Post—The postal rate for book packets is ½d. for 2oz.

Registration—The fees for registering an inland letter or package are 2d., 3d., 4d., 5d., 6d., 7d., 8d., 9d., 10d., 11d., 1s., 1s. 1d., 1s. 2d., according to compensation scale. Letters containing coin must be enclosed in a registered letter envelope, sold at all Post Offices. Registered postal packets must not be posted in a letter box, but should be handed to an officer at the Post Office and a receipt obtained.

Parcel Post—Not exceeding 1lb., 3d., and 1d. for every additional 1lb. up to 9lb. Exceeding 9lbs., and not exceeding 11lbs., 1s.

**FOREIGN POSTAL RATES.**

The rate for letters to all parts of the world is now uniformly 2½d. for half an ounce, and for book packets ½d. for every 2oz. The rate for letters for Canada, India, and certain other British Colonies is now 1d. for half an ounce.

**POSTAL ORDERS.**

Orders for 1s. and 1s. 6d., ½d.; 2s., 2s. 6d., 3s., 3s. 6d., 4s., 4s. 6d., 5s., 7s. 6d., 10s., 10s. 6d., 1d.; 15s., 20s., 1½d.

Postal Orders are not payable at offices abroad except Malta, Gibraltar, and Constantinople.

**MONEY ORDERS.**

Not exceeding £1, 2d.; £3, 3d.; over £3 and not exceeding £10, 4d.

No single Money Order may be issued for a higher amount than £10.

Money Orders are issued to most foreign countries at the following uniform rates: 6d. for sums not exceeding £2, 1s. not exceeding £6, and 1s. 6d. not exceeding £10.

**TELEGRAPH MONEY ORDERS.**

Not exceeding £3, 4d.; £10, 6d. In addition to the commission, a charge is made at the ordinary Inland rate for the official telegram authorising payment, the minimum being 6d. No single Telegraph Money Order can be issued for a greater amount than £10.

By Licence: Notice 1s., Certificate 1s., Stamp Duty 12s. 6d., Superintendent Registrar's fee £1 10s., Registrar's fee 10s., Copy of Marriage 2s. 7d. Notice to be given to either of the registrars of marriages or at the superintendent registrar's office. A notice without Licence becomes due after it has been entered 21 clear days in the Marriage Notice Book kept by the Superintendent Registrar. A notice by Licence becomes due after it has been entered one clear day in the said Notice Book.
